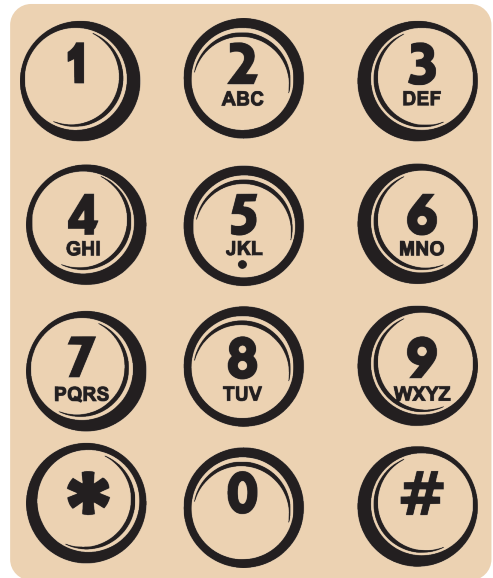


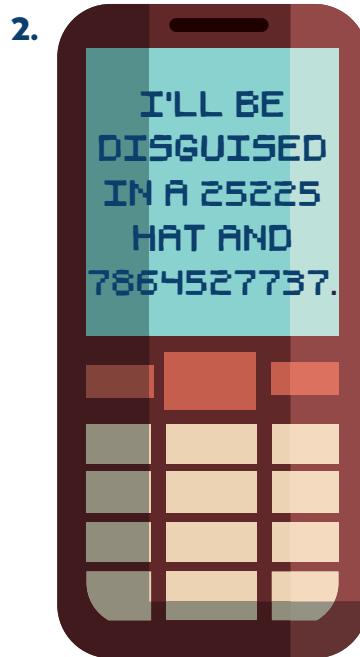
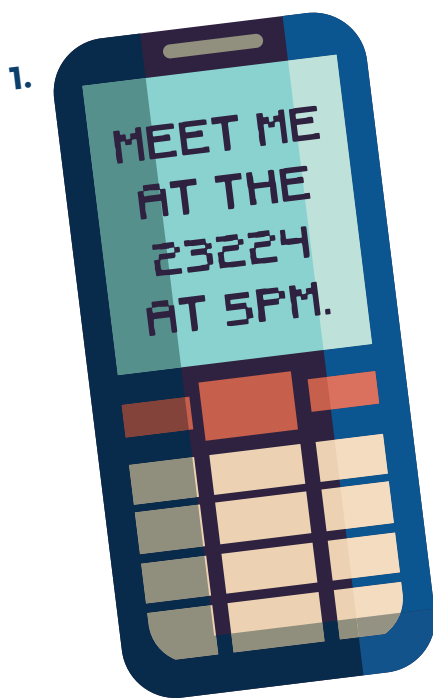
TEXTING CODE

 In the olden days (about 20 years ago!) people would text using a number keypad. Each number had letters connected to it like this

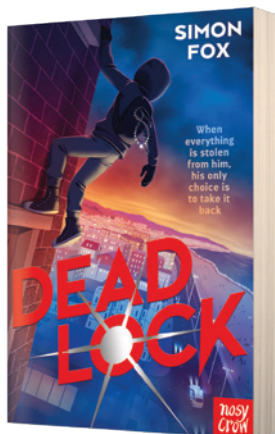


Example:
